

2015 ACCCESS TO JUSTICE LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD ZEV YAROSLAVSKY



The Board of Directors of Legal Aid Foundation of Los Angeles is proud to present the 2015 Access to Justice Award to Zev Yaroslavsky for his passionate advocacy of behalf of the poor and underserved communities LAFLA serves.

Zev Yaroslavsky served Los Angeles for more than 40 years, first as a city councilman and as a county supervisor from 1994-2014. He spearheaded multiple projects to reform both the LAPD and the LA Sheriff's Department, encouraging better relationships with the communities they serve. He also championed a compassionate, housing-first approach for the chronically homeless, which led to a permanent change to the county's previous policy.

Yaroslavsky was first elected in 1975, winning the Los Angeles City Council's coveted 5th District seat at the age of 26. On the council, Yaroslavsky tackled controversial issues, including the Los Angeles Police Department's use of excessive force and its improper spying on lawabiding residents. He co-authored two landmark initiatives — one that cut in half the size of new commercial developments near residential neighborhoods, and another that banned oil drilling along the city's shoreline.

In 1994, Yaroslavsky was elected to the five-member Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors, representing about two million people in the Third District. Because of term limits, he left office in 2014.

On the Board of Supervisors, Yaroslavsky quickly emerged as a leader on fiscal, health care, transportation, cultural and environmental matters. In 1996, he authored a park bond that preserved a broad swath of rural open space and spurred development of urban parks throughout the county. He also authored the 2002 Proposition 'B' trauma tax — a measure credited with saving two public hospitals from closing, keeping the county's emergency services intact.

In the area of social and human services, Yaroslavsky launched a series of groundbreaking initiatives that improved life for individuals and families on the margins of society. Yaroslavsky also has been credited with helping the region's chronically homeless through his widely praised Project 50 program and its spinoffs, which provided permanent supportive housing for hundreds of people who've been identified as most likely to die on the streets.

More recently, Yaroslavsky played a leading role in the sweeping reforms now under way in the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department. In 2011, he authored the board's motion to create a panel that investigated alleged deputy brutality in the nation's biggest county lockup and suggested dozens of measures to restore the department's integrity.

Yaroslavsky was born December 21, 1948 in Los Angeles, California. He earned an M.A. in British Imperial History and a B.A. in Economics and History, both from UCLA. He is a graduate of Fairfax High School in Los Angeles.

2015 Maynard Toll Award for Distinguished Public Service

HARRY PREGERSON



Judge Harry Pregerson was born to immigrant parents in East Los Angeles in 1923. After graduating from Roosevelt High School in 1941, he went on to attend UCLA, where he joined the Navy ROTC. In 1943, he was elected UCLA's student body president.

Judge Pregerson served in the Marine Corps during World War II. He was severely wounded during the Battle of Okinawa in 1945. After spending months recuperating at the U.S. Naval Hospital in San Diego, he finished his senior year at UCLA. He then enrolled at the UC Berkeley School of Law on the GI Bill and graduated in 1950. Judge Pregerson then returned to Los Angeles, where he started a storefront law practice in Van Nuys. He and his wife, Bern, a microbiology professor at Pierce College, raised their two children, U.S. District Judge Dean Pregerson and dermatologist Dr. Katie Rodan.

Judge Pregerson has served on the state and federal bench for over 50 years. Governor Pat Brown appointed him to the L.A. Municipal Court in 1965, then to the Superior Court in 1966. In 1967, President Lyndon Johnson appointed him to the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California. In 1979, President Carter appointed Judge Pregerson to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, where he continues to serve.

Judge Pregerson has dedicated much of his life to serving our community. As a district judge, he structured a consent decree that created thousands of affordable homes for people displaced by the construction of the I-105 Century Freeway. The consent decree established apprenticeship and employment programs for women and minority business enterprises. The interchange of the 110 and 105 freeways was officially named the "Judge Harry Pregerson Interchange" in recognition of his service.

Judge Pregerson later played a role in protecting public health when he required the City of Los Angeles to comply with the Clean Water Act and the Marine Protection Act. He ordered full secondary treatment for all wastewater processed by the Hyperion Wastewater Treatment Plant. The new treatment plant, which helped revitalize marine life in the bay, was named one of the Top Ten Public Works Projects of the Twentieth Century, along with the Hoover Dam, the Panama Canal, and the Golden Gate Bridge. For his efforts to modernize the treatment plant and reduce pollution in the Santa Monica Bay, Judge Pregerson was affectionately dubbed the "Sludge Judge."

Judge Pregerson is also a tireless advocate for the homeless, particularly for veterans and their families. Judge Pregerson has helped facilitate the construction of shelters, transitional housing, and child development centers throughout Los Angeles and Southern California. He played an integral role in establishing and maintaining the Salvation Army's Haven Program on the West Los Angeles VA campus; the Salvation Army's Westwood Transitional Village; the U.S. Vets' Westside Residence Hall in Inglewood; the U.S. Vets' Century Villages at Cabrillo in Long Beach; and the Salvation Army's Bell Shelter in East Los Angeles. Judge Pregerson continues to work closely with these facilities that provide a full range of social and supportive services, including mental health and medical care; transitional and permanent housing; job training and job development; child care; and hope for a brighter future.

Bono Service Award, recognizing its work
on behalf of domestic violence survivors
and victims of crime. Along with students
from UC Irvine School of Law, Orrick
attorneys from the Los Angeles and Orange
County office helped clients navigate the
US CIS system to help them obtain U Visas.

Orrick has contributed greatly to LAFLA's immigration projects. Since 2010, the firm has spearheaded the Immigration Permanency Project, a collaboration

between UC Irvine School of Law students, LAFLA and Orrick. A team of pro bono attorneys from Orrick supervises a group of law student volunteers to provide free legal services to low-income immigrant clients seeking green cards. Much of the project's success is due to Don Daybell, who doubled the number of attorney volunteers, handled logistics within the office, assisted with training and served as a mentor to the many students who had questions about the project.

Through the years the firm has worked on all types of immigration matters and gone the extra mile, assisting clients with adjustments and family reunification. While some firms shy away from cases when they get difficult (requiring additional documentation or support), Orrick has followed through on all of them. The firm has been one of the strongest supporters of our immigration work, devoting over 2,000 hours and over 70 Orrick attorneys and staff to just the Permanency Project. The firm has also taken on the task of training and supervising over 47 law students, who contributed almost 1,000 hours to the project.

"This project is a wonderful opportunity for us to have a significant and direct positive impact on the lives of individual clients who truly need our help," Daybell said. "I am glad that the firm's commitment to pro bono work allows us to put on projects such as this."

The Dolo Coker Scholarship Foundation Inc. is a nonprofit organization committed to assisting youth in their musical training and to perpetuating jazz by nurturing the seeds of jazz proficiency in the young minds and hearts of students.

In June, The Jazz Showcase takes place, featuring the scholarship recipients of the current year and a special guest artist. In September, a free Jazz Clinic is presented targeting high school and college jazz musicians from throughout Southern California.
