SPECIAL INCOME/ASSET EXEMPTIONS

Exempt from income & asset screening: applicants whose household income is solely derived from one or more of the following **means-tested public assistance** – SSI, GR, CalWORKs, CAPI. **Seniors** (60 & older) may be assisted if income meets the HUD/Other/Santa Monica guidelines under IOLTA funding.

ASSET GUIDELINES

Asset ceiling is \$50,000 for an individual (\$5,000 for each additional family member), and includes assets that can be readily converted to cash and are currently and actually available. Such assets include: cash, bank accounts, real property not lived in, vehicles not used for transportation, and unusually high value household goods. Assets that are exempt include primary residence, vehicles used for transportation, regular household goods (furniture, clothing, electronics, etc.), pensions, retirement plans, and special needs trust accounts.
