

Unemployment Benefits for Workers Affected by Los Angeles Wildfires

If you lost your job or income due to the recent wildfires in Los Angeles, you may be able to receive unemployment benefits from the California Employment Development Department (EDD).

Types of Unemployment Benefits

Regular Unemployment Insurance (UI)

- Who qualifies? Workers who lost their jobs through no fault of their own (for example, your workplace burned down or closed due to the fires).
- What does it provide? Up to \$450 per week for a maximum of 26 weeks while you search for new work.

Disaster Unemployment Assistance (DUA)

- Who qualifies? Workers typically not covered by regular unemployment, including:
 - o Self-employed individuals
 - o Religious workers
 - o Workers who recently started jobs and hadn't earned enough to qualify for UI
- What does it provide? Up to \$450 per week, available from 1/12/2025 through 7/12/2025.
- You will need:
 - o Proof of self-employment or non-covered employment in Los Angeles County
 - o Business records showing income from that employment
 - o An explanation of how the fire caused your loss of work or income\

How to Apply for Benefits

Both types of benefits use the same application. You may receive either UI or DUA based on your answers to the questions in the application. EDD may contact you for additional information or documents before making a decision.
